As a current 2017 Potlatch grantee, you or an individual that represents your organization are invited to participate in the 2017 Nonprofit Management / 2017 Language Preservation / 2017 Native Arts Cohort program.

Each cohort provides up to 75 hours of direct training and technical assistance over 10 months in topic areas specific to the cohort. Potlatch Fund expects each participant to successfully complete the cohort training activities by accomplishing at least 75% of training and technical assistance hours offered.

The knowledge and skills are acquired through completion of activities and participation in the monthly webinars, convenings, and technical assistance calls. The value of this cohort is approximately \$2,500 per person. The registration fee is \$500 per person to cover part of the expenses and is payable in monthly installments or in a one-time payment.
